FedLine Web[®] Certificate Removal

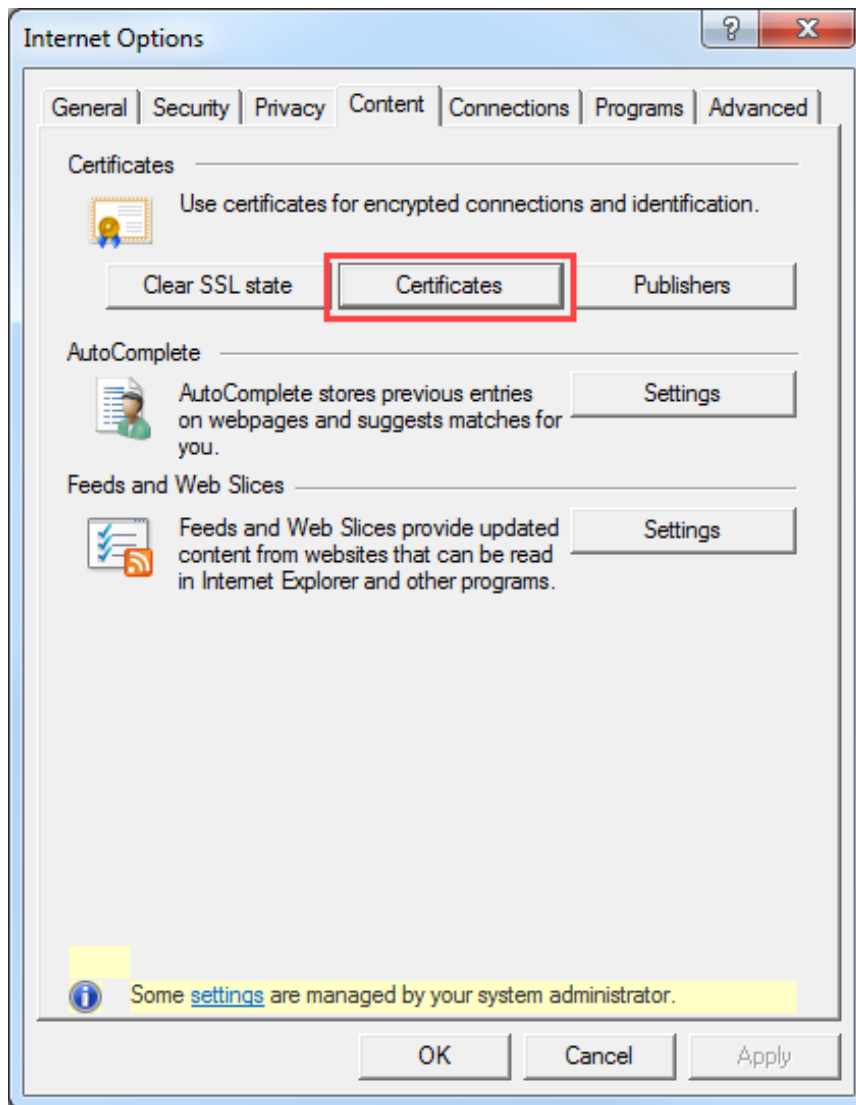

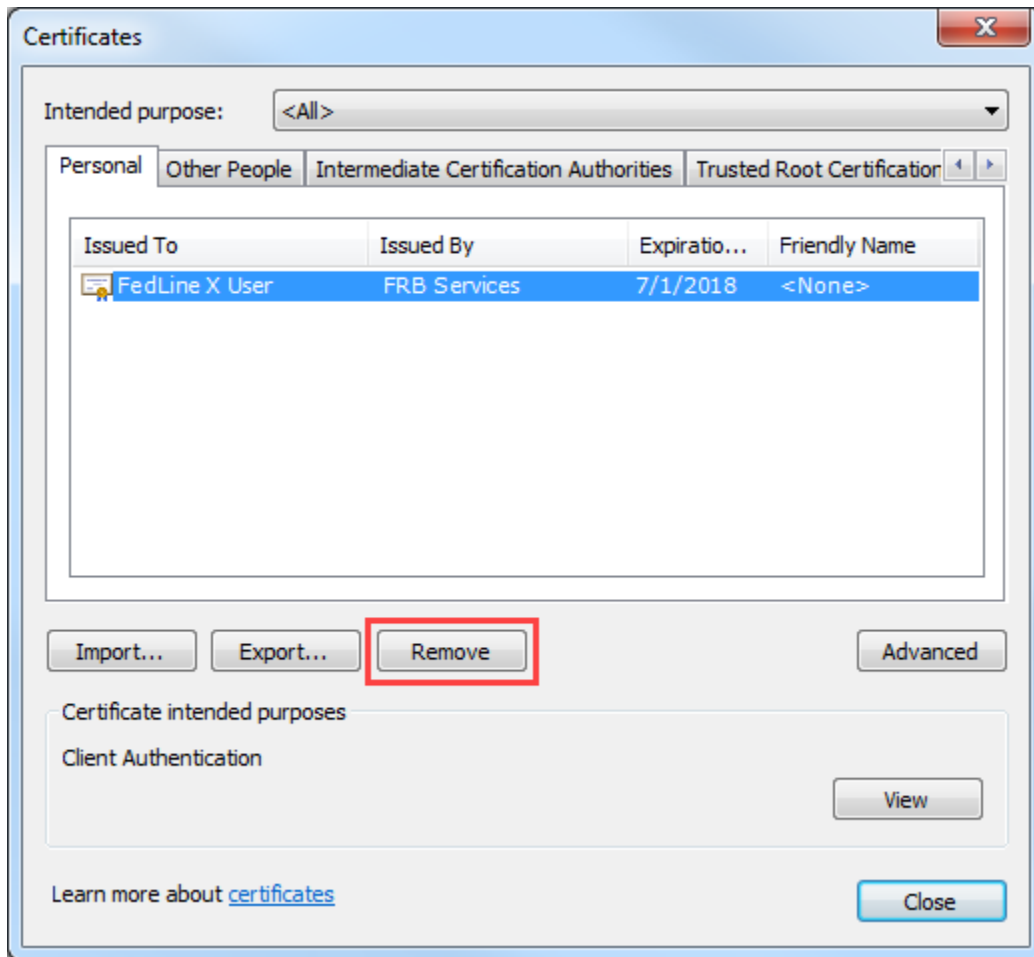

Certificate Removal Procedure

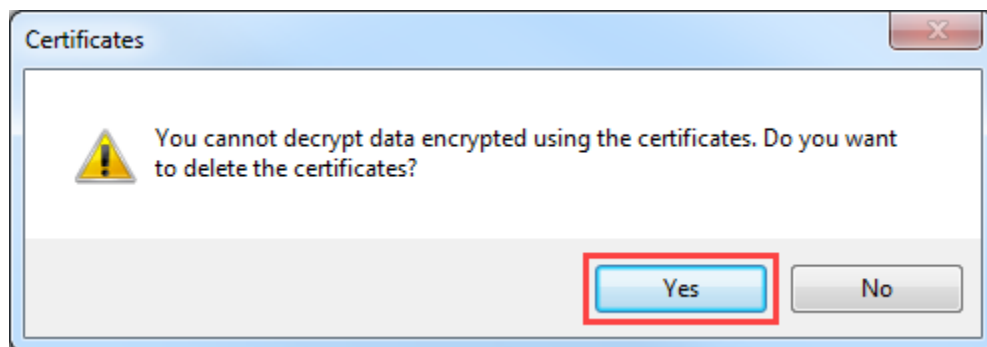
1. Open Internet Explorer. Click **Tools** → **Internet Options** → **Content**. Then click on **Certificates**.



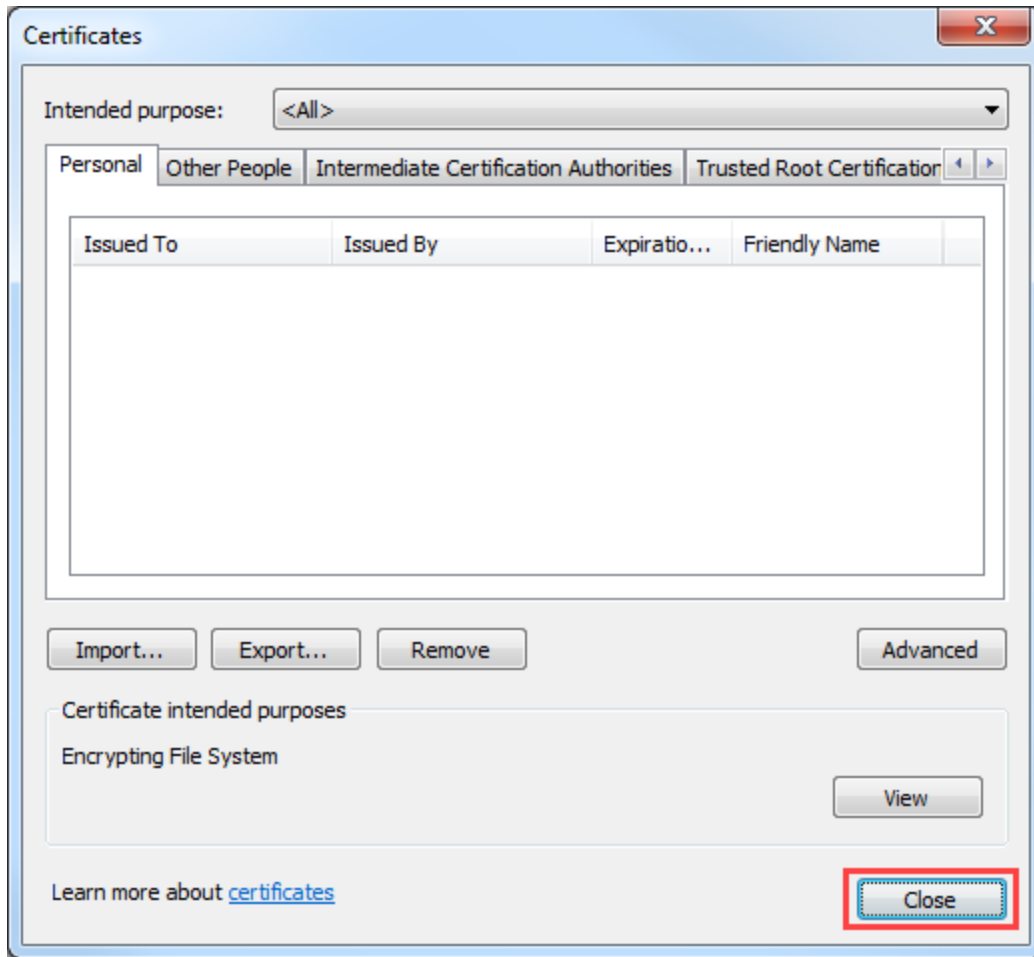
2. Highlight the certificate you want to delete and click **Remove**.



3. You might receive a warning asking “Do you want to delete the certificates?” Click **Yes**.



4. In order to verify that you have successfully deleted the digital certificate, click **Tools** → **Internet Options** → **Content** → **Certificates** and confirm that the certificate no longer appears in the certificate store. Then click **Close**.



This completes the certificate removal procedure.
